

Negley Run Watershed Task Force
Meeting Notes
March 22, 2018

- 1. PWSA/Little Negley Run Engineering** – Team is reviewing modeling assumptions. The Concept C is the most important – getting water to the River – is highest priority. NWRTF has a budget for community engagement, especially around the connection to the River. Offer to make it helpful as a vision start.
- 2. Liberty Green Update** – 90% design under discussion with PWSA. ~ 6 wks to completion of docs and still working on closing budget gaps. Things seem positive for summer construction start.
- 3. Community Water Team** – April 16-17 Sustainable Community Leadership Academy; group committing to covering community round tables around water issues; Larimer Green Team accelerating its work on an urban fruit tree orchard that needs water for irrigation.
- 4. Watershed Arts Action Team** – Discussion around possible role of arts in building community acceptance for major infrastructure investments. Art projects have to be funded from non-PWSA sources. How to position arts to marry design & placemaking.
- 5. Data & Mapping Team** – Work is ongoing and meeting is scheduled to define possible projects with Chatham thesis project.
- 6. RAND Corporation Project Presentation** – Jordan Fischbach, Kyle Siler-Evans, Devin Tierney, and Craig Bond present its upcoming modeling work on GSI flood reduction + cobenefits for Negley Run, hope to add 4MR. An 18 month project with target completion date June 2019. Intend to incorporate design proposals.
